CHURCH SCHOOL CONCLUDES SUMMER QUARTER

There is a class for everyone. Sunday Church School begins at 9 a.m. and ends in time for morning worship. Carol Smart is our Church School Superintendent. *Join us!*

In **August**, we'll conclude the Summer 2025 Quarter, "Sacred Altars & Holy Offerings" with Unit 3: "Christians and Sacrifice" where we'll turn to the New Testament letters (or *epistles*) to discover how the letters to the early Church help direct us in the proper ways of sacrifice.

"In the New Testament, particularly in the letters, the concept of sacrifice shifts from the ritualistic animal sacrifices of the Old Testament to a focus on the living sacrifice of believers and the ultimate sacrifice of Jesus Christ. Christians are called to offer themselves as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, a spiritual act of worship. This involves presenting our bodies, minds, and lives as instruments of righteousness, reflecting the love and sacrifice of Jesus." (- Google.com Ai Overview 7/24/25)
