

## **GIVE IT AWAY**

I want to share with you lots of statements of reality from God.

I say that because God is the only one in the universe who can create reality with His words.

In the first chapter of Genesis, six times He said "let there be", and this thing we call the universe came out of absolutely nothing because He said so.

In Isaiah 55 God said, "My words are not like your words."

He says everything I say will, not might, will accomplish everything I send it to do.

We have to always look at the scriptures that way. John chapter 1.1 says, in the beginning was the word, and the word was with God and the word actually was God.

So when we receive His word, we are actually receiving Him and His authority and power to make it our reality. Because if we don't we just received these as theory and concept, lofty ideals, and religious teachings, that we can discuss, argue about, but never walk in them.

My goal is not to increase your Bible knowledge. I intend to speak things that God has already spoken, already done and already committed His Holy Spirit to make our reality.

I've said many times that the scriptures show us that everything we receive as children of God is by inheritance.

The Apostle Paul prayed for believers, "that the eyes of your heart be flooded with Light, so that you would know the hope of His calling, the mind-boggling inheritance that He has made available to His children, and the incredible power He has made available in us and to us. Ephesians 1.17

So what is our inheritance as His children? Jesus said,

"The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I came that they may have My life, and have *it* abundantly. John 10.10

But, just how abundantly was He talking about?

Jesus explains. "Everything that the Father has is Mine; therefore I said that He takes of Mine and will disclose *it* to you. John 16.14

The Apostle Paul also declares what is included in our inheritance as His children.

That which eye has not seen nor ear heard, nor has ever entered into the heart of man, all that God has prepared for those who love Him. 1 Corinthians 2.9

But, how much abundance does one person need anyway?

Paul continues,

And God is able to make ALL grace abound to you, so that always having ALL sufficiency in everything, you may have an abundance for every good deed.... 2 Corinthians 9.8

Jesus said, all authority in Heaven and Earth had been given to Him, so that He could give eternal life to men. John 17:2

Jesus also told His disciples that all authority in Heaven and Earth belongs to me, now you go and manifest it as well. Peter and John got that revelation.

When they came upon the lame man begging at the beautiful gate, Peter said, "I do not possess silver and gold, but what I do have I give to you: In the name of Jesus Christ the Nazarene walk!"  
Acts 3.6

They did not stop and petition God to heal the man. They didn't pray at all. They drew on the massive inheritance of God's life, that Christ's perfect sacrifice and the impartation of His Holy Spirit made available to them and spoke God's word to the man. They witnessed not just a healing of the man's legs, but a creative miracle. The man had never walked before, but he rose up walking and leaping and praising God.

Do you remember the scripture in Romans 8.37 about becoming more than a conqueror? That used to puzzle me a lot. I could understand becoming a conqueror but how do you become more than a conqueror?. I asked the Holy Spirit one day to explain it to me and he said that becoming a conqueror is when we lay hold of Christ's victory for ourselves, but becoming more than a conqueror is when we lay hold of his abundance so that we can impart Christ' victory to someone else.

Jesus said I've given you my life in abundance. It's more than you can use so that you can give it away to other people.

God's plan was not to buff us up and make us completely capable in ourselves. He said the best I can do for you is to kill you and give you my life.

Salvation is God's Supernatural work for only one purpose and one purpose only to completely transform us, spirit, soul, and body, into the likeness of Christ.

His plan was not to get us to say a prayer, attend church meetings faithfully, and attempt continual behavior modifications to straighten up our helpless lives.

He says the best thing that I can do for you is to give you me.

Religion for generations has been saying that Jesus was an incredibly special case and no one could ever walk in what He did. But then He imparted the same Spirit to His disciples who continued to manifest the same things that He was doing.

Jesus's own words defy this concept. He said,

"Truly, truly, I say to you (my paraphrase would be, I really really mean this).

he who believes in Me, the works that I do, he will do also; and greater works than these he will do; because I go to the Father. John 14.12

By His doing you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God, and righteousness and sanctification, and redemption... 1 Corinthians 1.30

The Father put us in Christ supernaturally, so that Christ could become our ability.

And Romans 8:29 declares that we've been predestined from the beginning to be conformed to Him.

The Apostle Paul prayed God's intention for all of His children.

I pray that you may be able to comprehend with ALL the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ which surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled up to ALL the fullness of God.

God has made it quite clear what his intention is for this world through His children.

He intends for ALL the saints to be filled up with all the fullness of God and see God do exceedingly abundantly beyond anything we could ever ask or think by the power of His Spirit that lives in us. Ephesians 3.14-21

Now this is not some religious twist on an obscure scripture somewhere in the Bible. God is coming right out and saying I am speaking this to you because I actually intend to do it.

We tell a great story, but we just can't manifest it very well. Which is what God intends to do through all of his children.

I don't know what you think. I think it's a sad commentary that for generations the church has been praying the sinner's prayer, attending church faithfully, studying the Bible, reading Christian books, and going to Christian conferences and not one person over the generations has ever walked in all the fullness of God which He has promised to do in ALL of His saints.

And we've grown very comfortable with a purely academic presentation of the Gospel of His Kingdom.

Are you familiar with what a blood Covenant is?

I had no idea what a blood Covenant was . My first exposure to a blood Covenant was on television. When the Lone Ranger and Tonto cut their skin and rubbed their hands together and became Blood Brothers. But I had no idea what that really meant.

Blood covenants are one of the oldest agreements between men. One of the ways that a blood Covenant was ratified was that two men would cut their skin squeeze a few drops of blood into a glass of wine. They would each drink half of the glass ratifying the Covenant.

The one that most people have heard of was with Jesus At The Last Supper. Jesus said this is the Covenant in my blood. And when they drink the cup they were ratifying the Covenant with Jesus.

A blood Covenant signifies that everything I am and everything I have is available to you and when you drink the cup you're committing that everything that you are and everything you have is available to Me and you are accepting my commitment to be everything to you.

God not only gave us a blood Covenant promise so that we would trust Him, but He also added a personal oath on top of that to give us an even stronger motivation to believe and trust in the mind-boggling inheritance that He's given to us to empower us to accomplish His eternal purposes for this entire world and everyone in it.

Let me read it to you.

In the same way God, desiring even more to show to the heirs of the promise the unchangeableness of His purpose, interposed with an oath, so that by two unchangeable things in which it is impossible for God to lie, we who have taken refuge would have strong encouragement to take hold of the hope set before us. Hebrews 6.17

I'm speaking this to you so that you can lay hold of this inheritance that I've made available to you.

Jesus told the Pharisees that the kingdom of God would not come with outward observation, but it's within you.

He explained in John 14 how that would happen. He said that the Holy Spirit, He and the Father would make their permanent dwelling place in us.

God has committed everything He is and everything He has to His children as their inheritance so that wherever they go they can carry the Kingdom of God, with all of its authority and power into every negative situation.

It doesn't matter what the situation is. We just carry the kingdom of God into that situation and give Him the opportunity to be God. And nothing is impossible to Him.

Listen to this statement of Reality from God.

For in Him (Christ) the whole fullness of Deity (the Godhead) continues to dwell in bodily form [giving complete expression of the divine nature].

And you are in Him, made full *and* having come to fullness of life [in Christ you too are filled with the Godhead—Father, Son and Holy Spirit—and reach full spiritual stature]. And He is the Head of all rule and authority [of every angelic principality and power]. Col 2.10amp

Jesus told His disciples that, John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now.” and

"you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth.”

Acts 1.5 + 8

The word baptized means being totally submerged in the Holy Spirit until we overflow.

Let me conclude with two more statements of reality.

The people who know their God shall prove themselves strong *and* shall stand firm and do exploits for God. Daniel 11.32

For with God nothing is ever impossible *and* no word from God shall be without power *or* impossible of fulfillment. Luke 1.37

This is our calling and our destiny as His children. He is our inheritance.

He gave us our inheritance in abundance so we would have plenty to give away.

Let's ask the Holy Spirit every day to open our eyes to comprehend it, and expand our capacity to receive everything that He's made available to us, so that we would be fully equipped to manifest Him to this world.
