

## **EAT IT ALL**

Do you remember the story of Jesus feeding over 5,000 people with a little boy's lunch? After Jesus fed the 5000, they followed him.

In John 6:26 Jesus told the people who followed Him, truly truly I say to you, you seek me, not because of you saw the signs, but because you ate the loaves and we're filled.

Do not work for the food which perishes, but for the food which endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man shall give to you, for on Him the Father, even God has set His seal.

Verse 28

What shall we do, that we may work the works of God. Jesus answered them this is the work of God that you believe in Him whom He has sent.

Verse 30

So they said to Him, "What then do You do for a sign, so that we may see, and believe You? What work do You perform? "Our fathers ate the manna in the wilderness;

Verse 32

Jesus then said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, it is not Moses who has given you the bread out of heaven, but it is My Father who gives you the true bread out of heaven.

The bread of God gives life to the world. They said, then give us this bread.

Verse 35

I am the bread of Life. He who comes to me shall not hunger. He who believes in me shall never thirst.

They wanted bread for their temporary life in this world. He was offering them an eternal, unlimited, covenant relationship with God.

Now in John 4:14 Jesus said to the woman at the well, everyone who drinks of this water will thirst again, but whoever drinks in the water that I shall give him shall never thirst, but the water that I give him shall become in him a well of water springing up to eternal life.

And during the great feast in John 7.37, Jesus said, if any man is thirsty, let him come to me and drink. He who believes in me as the scripture said from his innermost being shall flow rivers of Living Water.

He also said,

Truly truly I say unto you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood you have no life in yourselves. He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life and I will raise him up on the last day. John 6:53

He came to create His Life in us. He wants us to swallow it and allow it to completely transform us into His image.

In Jesus's Parable in Matthew 13, He said that the kingdom of God is like leaven that a woman put in three measures of meal, until the whole lump of dough was leavened.

I think it's significant that it was three measures of meal. God wants us to swallow the Word of His kingdom until we are completely transformed spirit, soul, and body.

In 1 Peter 1:23, Peter says, that you have been born again not of seed which is perishable, but imperishable, that is, through the living and abiding Word of God.

God's Word isn't a teaching.

John 1.1 declares that Jesus actually IS the Word of God

At the last supper in Matthew 26, while they were eating, Jesus took *some* bread, and after a blessing, He broke *it* and gave *it* to the disciples, and said, "Take, eat; this is My body." And when He had taken a cup and given thanks, He gave *it* to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you; for this is My blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for forgiveness of sins. Jesus offered them this meal under the New Covenant.

God instituted the first Passover meal in Egypt. It was to bring about the complete supernatural deliverance for His people that only God could do.

He was saying, I have made a perfect supernatural provision for your release. Hear my voice, do what I say and I will bring the deliverance.

When he spoke of His provision for their deliverance, He told them to eat it all and leave nothing till morning.

In other words I made a perfect deliverance for you by my own doing, I don't want you to nibble at it or pick at it.

I want you to swallow it whole and see my perfect will come to pass in your life.

I've shared with you His word that He has already spoken, the perfect provision He has already made, and the Holy Spirit has been given to make it our reality.

Let's eat up.
