## MAKE HIM KNOWN

So that we can be filled up with all the fullness of God and so that God can do exceedingly abundantly. beyond anything we could ever dare ask or think by the power of His Spirit within us. Ephesians 3.18-20

But our natural senses protest, "that's way beyond my ability. I could never ever do that." That's why I've said many times, that the Gospel is supernatural and God is the only one who can do it.

God's plan to fill the Earth, and everyone in it with His glory, will not come to pass with an incomplete and purely academic presentation of His complete and total deliverance of His children. Fullness is not an option. It's a necessity to make God known.

1 John 4.16 amp
