

Marple Newtown Weather and Information Net Script

Pre-Net Announcement (8:28 AM)

Good morning, this is (call sign). The Marple Newtown Amateur Radio Club's Weather & Information Net is due to start in about 2 minutes. Of course, emergency traffic can break into the net at any time, but if you have an urgent need for the W3DI repeaters or priority traffic to pass on them before the net begins, please call (call sign) now.

[Make sure you bring up Echolink now]

Net Start Script (8:30 AM)

Good morning and welcome to the Marple Newtown Amateur Radio Club's Weather and Information Net for (day & date). This net runs daily starting at 8:30 AM and usually continues until all check-ins are acknowledged. All licensed amateurs are welcome to check in and participate in the net.

The net uses the linked W3DI repeaters located in Newtown Square, PA using the frequencies of 147.195 MHz with a PL tone of 100 Hz, 442.25 MHz with a PL tone of 131.8 Hz, and via Echolink using the call sign of N3RJV-L.

This is a directed net meaning that proper net protocol is in place where all traffic, check-ins and comments are to be directed through net control. My call sign is (call sign), my name is (name) and I will be the net control station for today.

We will start with mobile, portable, short time & QRP stations, then Echolink and then general check-ins.
