CALL TO ORDER:

John, WA3KFT, brought a 6m converter with power supply and various photos of his antenna system, plus photos of past field day activities.

Mark, NI20, brought various micro controllers that he had designed and built, including a controller for telescope alignment;

Erin, KM4WSK, showed the Heathkit pieces for an HF project she is working on, plus a digital transceiver for 10-40 meters.
