The information below is regarding some issues with our new daily 10 panfish limit on Lake Iola, so I contacted our DNR Warden, Jonathan Kaiser. He reported the following, which I think is good information to share:

"I have been working to check anglers on several occasions as well as watching "from a distance" to check for compliance. We will continue to focus on education and monitoring Lake Iola moving forward as well as I can say that all of the anglers I have spoken with thus far have been aware of and compliant with the new regulation.

Of course Warden Kaiser can not monitor our lake 24/7, so I encourage you to contact him directly when you are certain of any violations that you would like him to address. Thank you.
