## Village of Iola Board Hearing

Monday November 9th, 2020 @ 5:30 p.m.

Community Center, Senior Room, 180 S. Main St, Iola WI

Proper notice has been posted and given to the press in accordance with Wisconsin Statutes so the citizenry may be made aware of the time, place, and agenda of this meeting.

President Pro-Temp Dave Harper called the Public Hearing of the Village Board of Trustees to order. This Public Hearing was held in the same room simultaneously with the CDA Board Meeting. Regarding Resolution 20-08 WHEREAS, Summit Street between Iola Street and State Street is no longer necessary for a public roadway and essentially has been abandoned for more than five (5) years. Board members present: President Joel Edler, Trustees: Jim Rasmussen, Missy Fenn, Kathy Briquet, Dave Harper, Pamela Parks. Others present clerk Betty Aanstad, Sergeant Fields. No members of the public present.

Jim Rasmussen made a motion to dispense with reading Resolution 2020-08. Pamela Parks seconded it. Motion carried.

President Pro-Temp David Harper entertained a motion to approve the Resolution 2020-08. Jim Rasmussen introduced Resolution 20-08; Pamela Parks seconded. Motion Carried. Recommended to 6 p.m. board meeting.

A motion was made at 5:40 p.m. by Jim Rasmussen to adjourn the meeting, Pamela Parks seconded. Motion carried. The meeting was adjourned by Dave Harper @ 5:45 p.m.

Text of the Resolution discussed at the hearing and adopted by the 6 p.m. board of Trustees meeting that followed appears below.

### RESOLUTION NO. 20-08

A Resolution of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Iola, State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wisconsin Statute 66.1003. The Village of Iola declares its intention to abandon that portion of Summit Street located North of Iola Street and South of State Street.

**WHEREAS**, Summit Street was dedicated to the public when the original plat was adopted by the Village Board; and

**WHEREAS**, said portion of Summit Street between Iola Street and State Street is no longer necessary for a public roadway and essentially has been abandoned for more than five (5) years; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village now wishes to discontinue and abandon said portion of Summit Street pursuant to the above referenced Wisconsin Statute.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Iola as follows:

1. It is the intention of said Board of Trustees to abandon and discontinue the portion of Summit Street located North of Iola Street and South of State Street. Said street is more particularly described on Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated by reference.
2. The abandonment hereinabove described is contingent upon a reservation as follows:

The Village of Iola reserves a non-exclusive vehicular and equipment access easement for purposes of maintaining and improving the water line located underneath that portion of Summit Street.

3. A public hearing to consider adoption of this Resolution shall be held at the offices of the Village Hall located at 180 South Main Street, Iola, Wisconsin 54945 on Monday, November 9, 2020 at 5:30p.m.

4. Said Notice shall be in the form attached hereto as Exhibit 8.

5. Said Notice shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in Waupaca County for three (3) successive weeks preceding the date set for the hearing.

6. A copy of said Notice shall be posted conspicuously at three (3) locations within the Village of Iola at least two (2) weeks prior to the date fixed for the hearing.

7. A copy of said Notice shall also be mailed to the owner or owners of all adjoining lands. The foregoing Resolution was duly and regularly adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Iola at a regular meeting starting at 6 p.m. of said Board of Trustees held on the 9th day of November 2020, by the following vote:
