Work on New Golf Course Progressing

Work on Iola's nine-hole golf course at American Legion Park is going along nicely at present, according to members of the organization sponsoring the sport here. Nine cups and as many T-off places have been constructed at various points on the forty-acre plat at Legion Park. Three holes of the course will be located to the east of the baseball diamond with the number one hole near the highway on the east side of the park. The six other holes will be located west of the Legion dance pavilion.

The actual work of placing cups, flags and T-off places has been done. Several loads of stones have been removed from the fairways and this week by-gooses have been built in the fences about the course.

It is expected that the work of measuring the course and establishing par for the various holes will be completed by the end of the week.

A group of about 25 local people have taken interest in the golf course project and contributions from the body will be used to finance the venture. Labor and material used in the construction of the course thus far have been contributed by the group.

Note: Highway noted in first paragraph, east side of the park is County Road J in the area of Pine Tree Lane.

The 6 holes west of the Pavilion would be located across the street of Meadow Road and to the east the Iola Sentry Food.
