**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Notice is hereby given that on Monday, November 8<sup>th</sup>, 2021 at 5:30 o'clock p.m. p.m. the Board of Trustees of the Village of Iola will hold a public hearing at the Community Center, Senior Room which is located at 180 South Main Street in the Village of Iola, Wisconsin to consider amending the Village of Iola Code of Ordinances (1) Section 197-4 Park Hours and (2) Section 251-45 Private Well Abandon as follows:

**PROPOSED RESOLUTION**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Iola that Section 197-4 (A) of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 197-4 (A)

A. Park Hours. All Village Parks shall be closed from 10:30 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.

**PROPOSED RESOLUTION**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Iola that Section (C)(2)(6) and new subparagraph (G) of Section 251-45 of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

Ordinance 251-45 (E)(2)


C. Well Operation Permits

(2) The well and pump shall have a history of producing safe water evidenced by at least 2 coliform bacteria samples taken a minimum of 2 weeks apart. In areas where the Department of Natural Resources has determined that groundwater aquifers are contaminated with substances other than bacteria, additional chemical tests may be required to evidence safety of the water. Laboratory analysis by a certified laboratory shall be completed every five (5) years, per Department of Natural Resources maximum time frame and submitted with the permit application."

(6) Payment of a \$10.00 permit fee (5 years).

(G) INSPECTION. The water utility may inspect or arrange for an inspection of property served by the public water system for cross connections. As an alternative, the water utility may require a person, firm or corporation who owns, leases or occupies property to have their plumbing inspected, at their own expense by a State of Wisconsin Certified Cross Connection Inspector/Surveyor. The frequency of inspections shall be established by the water utility in accordance with Wisconsin Administrative Code. Any unprotected cross connections identified by the inspection shall be promptly corrected. Failure to promptly correct an unprotected cross connection shall be sufficient cause for the water utility to discontinue water serve to the property, as provided under paragraph \_\_\_ of this Ordinance.
