

MINUTES

Village of Iola Regular Meeting~Monday December 13th, 2021 @ 5:00 p.m.
Community Center, Senior Room, 180 S. Main St, Iola WI

The meeting was called to order by President Schustek at 5:04 p.m. at the Village of Iola Community Center in the Senior Room. Open meeting statements were made by President Schustek "This meeting and all other meetings of the Iola Village Board are open to the public. Proper notice has been posted in accordance with Wisconsin Statutes so the citizenry may be aware of the time, place and agenda of this meeting."

President Schustek led the Pledge of Allegiance and was followed by a moment of silence. Roll call was taken. Members present: President Jennifer Schustek; Trustees Missy Fenn, Dave Harper, Rick Meyers, Terry Murphy, Pamela Parks, and Jim Rasmusen. Others present: Clerk Betty Aanstad, Chief Paul Zierler, Holly Neuman, Village Attorney Bruce Meagher.

Trustee Harper made a motion to approve the minutes from the Monday November 8th, 2021, Board Meeting. Trustee Murphy seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Trustee Harper explained about the Line of Credit and why the Village of Iola borrows it each year. The Line of Credit is a revolving loan that is used to fund the village when the cash flow is short throughout the year, between state and county payments. It is only used to smooth cash flow.

Resolution 2021-13 with consideration of approval for 2022 Line of Credit Borrowing (\$200,000.00) was proposed by President Schustek. Trustee Harper introduced Resolution 2021-13. Trustee Meyer seconded the motion. Number of members present – 7, Number of members voting yes – 7, Number of members voting no – 0. Resolution 2021-13 2022 Line of Credit Borrowing (\$200,000.00) passed unanimously.

Trustee Murphy made a motion to approve Diana Jones as a 2022-2023 Election Official for the Village of Iola. Trustee Fenn seconded the motion. Motion carried.

At the November 8th, 2021, Village of Iola Board Meeting, the board also approved as Election Officials for the Village of Iola 2022-2023 term: Chief Inspectors: Shannon Dane & Richard Meyers. Election Officials: Brent Frankenhoff, Barb Kobs, Sherry Neidert, Sandy Bostwick, Nancy Morris, Angie Nielsen, Jeanne O'Keefe, Liz Tindal, Pamela Parks.

Trustee Rasmussen made a motion to postpone discussion and amending personnel policies for another time and place. Trustee Murphy seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

Trustee Murphy made a motion to approve a Class A Retail Beer License Application for Cenex Station, 305 North Main Street. Trustee Rasmussen seconded the motion. Motion Carried.
