CREDIT CARDS: The Village of Iola is know accepting credit card payments for your utility bills. If you wish to pay your bill, online go to www.villageofiola.com and click on bill pay.

SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL: This is a reminder if you have sidewalks in front of your properties or live on a corner lot with sidewalks on two sides. You are required by Village of Iola Ordinance 233-10 to remove the snow and ice. Please go to the Ordinances on our website if you wish to see the complete ordinance. If you have not cleared the sidewalks within 24 hours from the time the snow/rain have stopped, the village will clear them for you at your expense for each time we have to clear them.

GARBARGE DISPOSAL: Remember if you have not returned your garbage pickup survey slips yet that were sent out with property taxes, please remember to do so. At this time, we do not have enough responses for what is required by the companies we have talked with, so please make sure you get your slip in or remind your neighbors.

DOG LICENSE: If you own a dog in the Village of Iola it is required to be registered in Waupaca County. The dog needs to be registered in the municipality that the dog resides. For Village of Iola residence, you can obtain a license at the village clerk's office in Iola. For spayed & neutered dogs the cost is \$3.00; Dogs that are not spayed or neutered the cost is \$8.00. You will need to provide a copy of your dog's veterinary records showing that the date they received their rabies vacation and the expiration date.

DOG PARK: The village has approved a location for the dog park. The location is the village property located at the corner of Town Line Road and W. Iola Street (Mediacom satellites were previously located there) Trustee Rick Meyer is putting together a committee to help with the planning and fundraising stages. Some people have already expressed interest in being on this committee. I have forwarded those names on to Rick if you want to call and confirm he received it feel free too.
