Greetings,

A new year brings a feeling of a fresh start. We have achieved many great things in the Village in 2023 and we are hoping 2024 bring even more wonderful changes to the village. We want to take this time to highlight a few things:

- SNOW STORM INSTRUCTIONS: Please move vehicles off streets prior to snow storms. This helps our public works department with snow removal.
- RIVERWALK: The riverwalk is closed until repairs can be made. Give the clerk's office a call for information about how you can help.
- YARD DEBRIS: Tree branches and brush can be dropped off at Townline Road dumping location. Grass, leaves, and pine needles can be dropped off at Grove Street Location. These dump sites are for village residents. Yearly out-of-town permits for dumping are available at the clerk's office.
- GARBAGE PICKUP: Just a reminder that Harter's pick up is early Monday, unless Holiday then pick up is Tuesday. Please make sure your containers are facing forward, otherwise they will not be emptied.
- SEWER RATE INCREASE: Starting in January, Sewer rate will increase, per unit, from \$125.00 to \$127.00.
- IOLA REGIONAL RECYCLING FACILITY Garbage tag prices effective January 1st 2024, will be \$4.00 for one (1) tag or a sheet of five (5) for \$20.00. Tags can be purchased at: Iola Sentry Foods, the Village of Iola Clerk's Office or Iola Regional Recycling Facility (405 W. State St, Iola WI 54945) Hours: Saturday's 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., Thursday 2:00 PM - 4:00 PM (October – March) and 3:00 PM – 6:00 PM (April -Sept)

ORDINANCE REMINDERS:

🐵 🛛 Tree Trimming 🚳

Please be sure that branches are at least 10 feet above sidewalks and 14 feet above streets. Please reference <u>ordinance 240-9</u> for details.

[®] Snow and Ice Removal≉

In the event of snow and ice accumulating on sidewalk, the owner, occupant, or person in charge of any parcel or lot, is responsible for clearing said sidewalk within a day and a half of the completion of the winter event. Sidewalks are to be kept clear of snow and ice to a minimum of four feet in width. If ice has formed on any sidewalk in such a manner that it cannot be rem oved, the owner, or person in charge of the parcel or lot shall keep the sidewalk sprinkled with sand and/or salt to permit safe travel by pedestrians. Please reference <u>ordinance</u> <u>233-10</u> for details.
