Meeting called to order at 9:00 AM by Chair S. Peterson. The open meeting statement was read by S. Peterson.

G. Tetzlaff informed the committee that Well 3 needs casing replaced. Should have a cost to replace in a few days. A bid on a 2013 International 7400 Single Axle DRW Patrol/Dump Truck w/plow and spreader has been made, through Wisconsin Surplus Online Auction. The auction ends at 11:00 am, today. March 3, 2025. Glenn said the highest he would bid would be \$30,000.

D. Harper made a motion to bid out this year's road improvements on West McKinley Street, Fairway Drive and East Taylor Park Roadway for paving and adding gravel shoulders. S. Peterson seconded. Motion passed. L. Krogwold will go ahead and get the ad in the Waupaca County Post, so we can get bids in early April.

Current delinquent utilities report was looked over and it was decided that if the person is two payments behind and amount is over \$100.00, they would receive a disconnection letter and disconnection would be done on March 14th. Public Works would hang a notice of shut off 48 hours prior to shut off. Those residents that broke their DPA contract with the Village will receive a special letter stating that they need to come into office and make an arrangement with us.
