Projects proposed consists of pulverize existing asphalt pavement from John Street to Adams Street of East Ellefson Street; South Jackson to termination of Hill Street; from starting of Water Street down 750 feet on Sunset Drive. Fine grade, water and compact the remaining pulverized/base course material. Provide traffic control, signage and flagging as needed. Saw cut existing pavement (if needed). Village of Iola will provide truck and loader and haul away excess pulverized material if needed. Due to a variety of bids please contact the village clerk's office for bid sheets for each project at 715-445-2913. Hot Mix Asphalt using type 4LT58-28 at 2.5 inches thickness. Driveway openings shall have a 1' asphalt approach placed at each entrance.

The Village of Iola will publicly open bids thus received at Village of Iola Hall, 180 S. Main St., Iola, WI 54945 at 10 a.m. local time on Friday, March 27, 2026. Winning bid will be rewarded off total for all projects.
