- Equipment
 - Stickers or numbers on helmets are not okay
 - (1) Per the manufacturer stickers or numbers could alter the structural integrity of the equipment
 - No shiny helmets – it's a rule
- 260 games in 4 weeks, it's a lot for Umpires
- If league needs a player's all-star information re-printed, it's \$3/kid
- Verification Binder Breakdown
 - There are 18 different types of residency proofs
 - (1) If a player uses 2 internet proofs, the 3rd must be a valid CDL
 - 3 Best
 - (1) CDL
 - (2) Auto Insurance
 - (3) Auto Registration
 - School forms – only one of the two needed (if school is within league's boundaries)
 - (1) School enrollment form only principal or vice principal are allowed to sign
 - (2) 1st quarter/semester report card (or any report card showing the 1st quarter/semester)
 - Order of the binder
 - (1) Player Affidavit
 - (2) Original Birth Certificate
 - (3) 3 Proofs/1 School Form
 - (a) Medical Release should be included and signed in any color other than black
 - Make sure TOC and All-Stars pins have been handed out to the teams
 - Summer Ball Classic – each team involved receives pins – schedules to be out soon
 - (1) 11/12 hosted by Concord American 8 teams
 - (2) 9/10 hosted by Continental 6 teams
 - For TOC, hand out ALL trophies
 - Hosting leagues have line-up cards for All-Stars and TOC games
 - Register for All-Star teams online
 - Adult Issues
 - (1) Seems to be a lot more issues between Little League Adults – coaches, parents, umpires, league officials
 - (a) Make sure the kids have fun
 - (b) Think twice about sending emails or posting on social media

- Make sure all TOC paperwork is completed for first games
