We had 40 students from 8 of our District 4 leagues in attendance at the clinic which is a fabulous turnout.

We just completed the preseason umpire training program. • Review the official interleague schedule on the CA4 Website

(<u>http://www.californiadistrict4littleleague.org/</u>) often to ensure all information are current.

- The traveling/away manager shall contact the host/home manager the night before their scheduled game to confirm they are expecting you, start time and field locations.
- If required the host leagues shall provide a printed copy of Ground Rules for the plate meeting.
- Host league shall provide at least 1 adult umpire on the field or an Adult Game Coordinator MUST be assigned to that one game.
- Start Time is the scheduled time unless for unforeseen delays... then the Start Time is the start of the umpires' plate meeting.
- Team Pitching Record forms are available on the CA4 Website

(<u>http://www.californiadistrict4littleleague.org/</u>) to track pitching eligibility.

- No new inning after 2 hours from the Start Time.
- A game called on weather or darkness is the sole discretion of the game umpires.
- A game called on Run Rule is a regulation game.

- A Tied Game after 2 hours of play shall not be rescheduled.
- A Rescheduled/Continuation game shall be reported to Liz Berg... (<u>RocketLiz@gmail.com</u>) and the responsibility of the two managers to schedule.
 - Cancelling a scheduled game... the team manager shall inform the opposing team manager and request message was received. The Host League shall inform the umpires.
