### District Administrator, Ted Boet:

- Live Scan: At this time every league should have at least started the process.

### Safety Officer ADA, Liz Berg:

- Each league must have their own ORI # before you can do the Live Scan
- Liz Berg and Michelle Vierra/Martinez LL can both do Live Scans. Meetings will be set up to do them.
- \$10 cost per person to recoup the \$5000 cost of the equipment
- Leagues will pay the DOJ/FBI fee
- I will send to each league the email address you should send the application for the Live Scan ORI
- Leagues must do the JDP background check if you do not have the Live Scan ORI

### Chief Umpire ADA, Don Waddell:

- Good to see all leagues represented and to see new faces tonight
- Umpire Trainings See the newsletter please
- League Volunteers Start with the parents of TeeBall players when they first enter the league, find something they are interested in helping Snack Bar, Umpiring, Scorekeeping, Field Work, Field Prep, then work towards being a board member. There are opportunities for leagues to seriously consider engaging adults to become umpires.
  - A. Umpires -
    - 1. Nominate adults to be an umpire for a game
    - 2. Some leagues assign umpire duties to teams
    - 3. Some leagues have the managers and coaches umpire
    - 4. Teenage umpires must have an adult as Game Coordinator at the game
  - B. Local Umpire Associations are very short on umpires, even High School Baseball and Softball will be severely impacted, they may not have many for Little Leagues
    - 1. You may not get the best umpires suited for Little League games from paid associations
    - 2. D4 Umpire Staff is available to help leagues to design a program best suited for you
  - C. Suggestions from leagues
    - 1. Concord American/Rick Munoz trying to get the league to provide equipment to volunteers who umpire
    - North/South Oakland/Paul Rosky For the last 15 years we have been providing a stipend each year to umpires to help with purchasing their equipment. Youth Umpires, we have one of their parents umpire with them.
- Fall Ball for Blues --these meetings are held once a month on Wednesday nights, we avoid holidays
  - a. Conducted by Zoom 90 minutes
  - b. Have invited 85 people, who are umpires from post season games or attended clinics, about 15-20 attend
  - c. Of those in attendance almost none have been league UICs
  - d. We cover equipment, training, new coaching/Little League program
  - e. Tomorrow the new Western Region UIC from Seattle Dennis Williams, taking over for Mark Bernstein at the end of the 2023 tournament season
  - f. Videos shown are from World Series games cover several topics: You Make the Call
