- a. Alameda/Ron Matthews -

 - 2. Fall Ball 260 kids. In past years it was half that amount. Parents feel more comfortable since it is outdoors. Other leagues are welcome to come play with us. Weekends only, all day, we have lights for Friday and Saturday nights.
- b. Albany/Frank Knowles -
 - 150 kids, Sundays only, Instructional. 50% more enrolled than what we thought would register. Annual meeting to be held soon to get ready for Spring Registration in a month.
 - Just an FYI to the leagues of D4 –we do not participate in Post Season due to our 11 & 12 year olds play Intermediate (50/70). We hold an internal All Star play for the league. It is very popular.

Response: Since 50/70 was introduced by Little League headquarters. About 7-8 years. First year was a big issue for the 11 & 12 year olds so they played 2 halves; 1st Half by Majors Rules and the 2nd Half by 50/70 Rules, 12 games each half. We sent a 12 year team to D4 All Star Tournament and they had a hard time transitioning to the smaller field. Next year 11 & 12 year olds played 50/70 and continue to do so; 9 & 10 year olds play Majors. Don't lose many kids to Travel Ball.

- c. Clayton Valley/Zack Torrey -
 - 1. Thank you to Alameda for hosting the 10-12 All Star Tournament, did a fantastic job, we had a great time.
 - 2. Fall Ball 235 kids, doubled from last year. Sundays only. Have talked to other leagues for play. Please let me know if interested.
 - 3. Spring Registration starts next month, hopefully for a "normal" year.
- d. Continental/Jake Spurlock -
 - 1. Paired with Walnut Creek LL for this next year for play
 - 2. Fall Ball 350 kids between Continental and Walnut Creek; Sundays only; No interest in interleague play due to having enough teams in house.
 - 3. Oakland A's Uniform donation once again we have ordered shirts & hats from the A's (1400 each). We hope to have to use all of them. Ordered them last week
