#### DA Ted Boet:

- Thank you all for coming tonight.
- Arnold Lum / Pinole Hercules LL received the Ron Matthews Award
- Frank Knowles / Albany LL attended services for past D4 Teenage Baseball ADA, David Preuss (74 years old)
- 2023 Lewis Cup monetary awards were handed out
- Charters: All 12 leagues have completed as of today.
- West Region: 630 leagues as of today, there were 655 leagues last year.
- California: 415 leagues as of today, there were 431 leagues last year.
- Registration: New change for 2025
  - a. 4 to 7-year-olds can register to play wherever they want (Siblings can go where their 4–7-year-old chooses to play).
  - b. Sports Connect: All leagues must use Sports Connect starting in 2025. Roughly half the leagues in D4 already use it.
- **Taxes**: File by February 15<sup>th</sup>.
  - a. Last year's (year 2022) are due to DA Ted today.
- Constitutions: 2<sup>nd</sup> six of the leagues will be submitted to West Region this year. The 1<sup>st</sup> six were submitted last year.

## Safety Officer ADA, Liz Berg:

- Live Scan:
  - **a.** Mobile Live Scan companies will come to your league.
    - 1. Team up with another league for a date to save on expenses.
  - **b.** JDP is still required to be completed even with the Live Scan.
- c. Live Scan checks DOJ Registry Custodian of Records receives message; FBI ONLY checks when submitted.
- ASAP: Is now open and you can submit anytime. You do not need to submit to Liz first.
  - **a.** MUST be submitted prior to holding Tryouts.
  - **b.** Give a date for Managers/Coaches Meeting and add the date to the league's calendar, otherwise it will be rejected.
  - **c.** If your league doesn't have any changes in the ASAP, update the Board of Directors and the Managers/Coaches Meeting, change 2023 to 2024 everywhere in the plan, then submit to LL headquarters.
- Abuse Awareness Training:
  - a. **All Volunteers** must complete the training every year after October 1<sup>st</sup> **or** the league can hold a meeting, keep track of who attended, then submit saying they completed the requirement.
  - b. The on-line training takes  $\frac{1}{2}$  to 1 hour to complete.

  - **a.** Leaping is no longer illegal pitch. Requirement: Pitcher must be within the width of the Pitcher's Plate facing towards Home Plate.
  - b. Seniors no longer will have a Designated Hitter (DH). Will follow High School and College DP Flex.
