#### **DA Ted Boet:**

Round Tables Report:

a. New Regulation 2.0 to begin in 2025 – 4–7-year-old can play in any league in any District Will only ever apply to 4–7-year old players

Players who are 8 years old can continue in league (not home league) till age out OR return to their Home League and stay till age out.

Any player between 4-7 can pick any league every year until the year they turn 8.

Older brothers/sisters can follow their 4-7 year old sibling to the league they registered to play; Still under discussion Red Shirt possibility.

Under discussion at headquarters – 6-year-old that plays in Not Home League that has an older sibling, If the 6 year old returns to the Home League does the older sibling have to return.

Since 1992 in California – any student can attend school in any school district as long as there is an opening for them; Set to Expire in 2028; talks are underway to extend it

Currently 5 ¼ million students K-12 grade attend school; Only 9600 students attend a school outside of their district.

- b. Starting next year all Registration will have to go through SportsConnect to a centralized registration point. Add a button/link to your website to take registrants to the site.
- c. Continuous Batting Order and 12 Players on the Team: It is still being discussed at remaining Round Tables to make it equitable.

## Safety Officer ADA, Liz Berg:

- ASAP: still waiting on three leagues to submit: Albany, East County and Pinole Hercules; Martinez needs to submit Registration
- Live Scan: Been receiving questions
  - 1. Each league MUST have their own ORI and Custodian of Records
  - 2. There will NOT be a District wide Live Scan Rolling
  - 3. Live Scan (State of California Requires) and JDP (Little League Required) are required for Volunteers
    - a. Anyone who has regular access to children
    - b. 16 hours per month and/or 32 hours per year
  - 4. Live Scan: Do not Check the box for FBI, nor pay for it. This will be completed by JDP.

- Umpire Safety with Children
  - a. Do not be in a one-on-one with a child
  - b. Should have two adults when waiting for a parent to pick up the child.

  - b. Follow the instructions

  - d. Required Information: Must be provided, if any is missing DA Ted Boet will return it to you to attach the info.
- Rule or Regulation Waiver
  - a. Must in a letter format specifying what rule or regulation you wish to not follow in terms of the Rule Book.
  - b. I will look it over and submit to headquarters if all information is provided.

  - b. App is free, everyone has access

- Little League University
  - a. LittleLeague.org/University courses that anyone can take: managers, coaches, league staff, volunteers and parents.
  - b. Education and Training at your own pace for Managers, Coaches, Parents
- **Diamond Leader Training Program** is required of all Managers and Coaches that participate in Post Season play a certificate is provided upon completion.
- USA Baseball Athlete Safety
  - a. Abuse Awareness Course for all Managers, Coaches and Volunteers: Required
  - b. Must be taken annually after October 1st Certificate is provided upon completion.
  - c. In the Drop Down for Leagues Choose Little League
  - d. User Directory: enter the required info except for organization (leave blank).

      - a. Upper half is TOC can enter one team in each Division, providing you have it during the regular season. Red Squares on your form indicate you did not have this Division during regular season.
      - b. Bottom half is for the International Tournament (All Stars)
      - c. Leagues can have one team at every Division except for Future Stars
        - 1. You can enter two teams for 9-11 Future Stars and 8-10 Future Stars.
      - d. Future Stars: Change to 8-10 to 7-8-9 year olds? Will vote at the March meeting to 9U and 11U
