  - a. Need to know in order to set a schedule for games

- Junior TOC and All Stars Need your Fields for Post Season play
  - a. There are 6 Junior and 6 50/70 teams signed up to participate in TOC and All Stars

### LL Baseball ADA, Geoff Shiu:

- TOC Small Diamond Majors and Minors will Use Interleague Rules; recommend using them now
  - a. Continuous Batting Order is in effect.
  - b. Interleague Rules are located on the D4 website on the Little League Baseball page.

### Softball ADA, Phil Raines:

- TOC and All Star Schedules will be available at the May meeting, brackets will be provided here
- Fields for Big Diamond / Teenage Baseball are Needed
  - a. TOC will end on Thursday of the week of TOC, many fields are needed for 50/70,
  - b. 50/70 All Stars must end the following week so that they get time to rest prior to Section, June 17 23 District
  - c. Please let me know if you have fields available with appropriate pitching mounds
  - d. Junior fields are needed for All Star tournament, All Stars June 24 28 or so

**DA Ted Boet:** To give you some perspective on the scheduling of the games by Don. I gave him the pairing that were determined by a random draw. If no one drops out there are 181 games to be played at the District level in 30 days which is 6 games per day.

- Tournament (TOC and All Stars) Meetings: Monday, June 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday, June 6<sup>th</sup> by Zoom, will need to Register.
  - a. Softball TOC/All Star meeting may be In-Person
  - b. Each Team must have one Representative at the Softball and Baseball meetings.
  - c. Each League is to have at least one Representative at the Tournament Director meeting.
- Safety Rules Please see the April Newsletter; the Rules are to protect the kids
  - a. Presidents please get the message out to the teams.

### West Region Tournament Chair, Paul Rosky (report given by Ted Boet):

- Albany LL made a donation for the Hospitality Room, Thank you
  - a. Please help out donation can be added to next year's Dues
  - b. Hospitality Room is the volunteer umpires that come to work the Senior Baseball tournament

### Safety Officer ADA, Liz Berg:

- RULES:
  - a. Coaches Do Not Sit outside of the dugouts
  - b. Break-Away Bases are to be used for 50/70 and Juniors
- Injury Reports: Leagues have been sending them in. Thank you I only need a copy.

### **DA Ted Boet:**

- May 1<sup>st</sup> Tournament Enrollment in the Data Center will be open for you to enter teams.
  - a. Fees per team: \$150 for 8–10 and 9-11 teams
  - b. Fees per team: \$300 for Little League on up
  - c. Future Teams are **NOT** to be entered into the Data Center
- Required forms for All Star and Tournament of Champions Teams
  - a. Locate the forms on the District 4 website, LL Forms page
  - b. TOC forms are on the left in Green
  - c. All Star forms are on the right in Red
  - d. President Letters
- An email from LL Headquarters will be sent to presidents and District Administrators tomorrow morning if you have not already received it. New next year:
  - a. Centralized registration will take place in Sports Connect

- b. Leagues will file their paperwork in the File Cabinet in the Data Center
  - 1. Reason: the incoming president will have access to the files
  - 2. Files will stay there forever: EOY Financial Statement; Budgets; Minutes for Meetings; Constitution; By-Laws
- c. Constitution: after being uploaded the West Region will receive an email, they will then review it
- Background Checks: 7 of the 12 leagues are up to date; in the Data Center on your league's page left column there is a box to check that you are in compliance – Background Check and Child Protection Compliance. You must do this to be tournament eligible. At this time Pittsburg, Albany, Clayton Valley, Lafayette, and East County have not completed this step, everyone else has.
- Today's Checklist: GREEN you have completed the item; BLACK you need to complete it at headquarters.
- Leagues: After reviewing the brackets at the May meeting if anything is incorrect we will make sure to get teams entered where they belong.
- Schedule for District tournaments:
  - a. I am attempting to have them completed prior to July 4th.
  - b. No softball over the July 4<sup>th</sup> weekend.
  - c. Junior Baseball Section will play July 4th weekend.
