- **Richmond LL** presented by Eva Padilla and Daniela Rueda: Unexpected death of 6 year old Armadeo Alvarez of Richmond LL in a car accident. He was an AA player, esteemed player. A big loss to the community. This occurred two months ago. Thank you to Ted and those who donated to the Go Fund Me; it was much appreciated by the family.
- Background Checks:
  - a. Two leagues have not completed the JDP background checks
  - b. Another league was contacted by West Region asking if they were doing the Live Scans. Somewhere else a Live Scan was reporting a Sex Offender/2004, this person is no longer in the league.

- 8. Player Affidavit generated in the Little League Data Center
- 9. Original Birth Certificate (for verification only, not kept in binder)
- 10. School Enrollment Form (SEF) Enrolled as of October 1st, 2023 or 3 (or more) Residency Proofs Good Dates are February 1, 2023 – February 1, 2024.
- Abuse Awareness Training is annual after October 1st
- Dress Code
- Patches Uniforms MUST have patches. Old or New style
  - a. All Star and TOC -
    - 1. 4 or less patches missing from uniforms = Lose a Base Coach
    - 2. 4 or More patches missing from uniforms = Lose both Base Coaches
- Teams
  - a. Every team MUST have 12 players unless DA Ted Boet grants a Waiver. 12 players must be listed and present at each new level of play. One injury can sit out, 11 play. Win to go to the next level you must have 12 players that can play.
  - **b.** Suspect a player lives outside the boundaries of another league You MUST provide PROOF.
  - c. Suspect a manager has a player staying home sick. If a habit shows Little League will find out and remove the team.
  - d. If adding a new player once the tournament has begun a new map and affidavit must be printed from the Data Center. Place the new paperwork in your binder and keep the old paperwork as well.
- Score Reporting for TOC and All Star Games responsibility of the Host to report the scores of games. Managers should also report the score. Text score to the number listed on the Bracket. Fines –
  - a. Host does not report the score of a game = \$10
  - b. Manager of each team that does not report the score = \$5
- TOC and All Star Brackets handed out league will only receive a bracket if you have a team playing at that level.
  - a. Tell Ted of incorrect listings of teams
  - b. New brackets will be created for the changes and emailed to leagues.
- Nor Cal Sections will be created an a possible October vote among the Nor Cal DA's will take place.
- Thank you everyone for what you are doing for your league and community for whatever reason you have.
