 - **d. Concord American** Evaluations started last weekend. Drafting the 1st weekend of February. Numbers are more than last year. Galindo will be playable this year.

- Rules Changes 2025 A complete list of the Changes are attached to the January Newsletter.
 - a. Background Checks Little League requires to be conducted by JDP
 - **b. Little League Abuse Awareness Training** Required after October 1st Annually. Link is located on the D4 website Forms page. Anyone who has repetitive contact with players must complete the training.
 - c. Senior Baseball and Softball No Mandatory Play
 - **d.** Senior Softball Interleague Mandatory Play is required.
 - **e. Rule 3.01 Umpires Checking Equipment** Is no longer required. I recommend the Presidents discuss this with your UIC on how your league wants to handle this change.

Suggestion: Continue having your umpires check the equipment. Remove the illegal equipment prior to game versus ejecting the manager and player during the game and subsequent game.

Umpire can ask the Managers if they want the equipment checked prior to the game. Now is the time to take care of anything. Avoid possible ejections.
