## Softball ADA, Phil Raines:

- **Scheduling Meeting:** February 12<sup>th</sup>, 6:30pm, at UC Cooperative, 2380 Bisso Lane, Concord. Two other districts will be in attendance.
  - a. Interleague: leagues will be interleague with all of the other leagues
  - b. Know the number of teams you have at each level
  - c. Be aware of the ages of players on your teams prior to scheduling games for Interleague. Match Age not necessarily Division to have competitive games, not slaughters. League 1: AA team players 7 & 8, League 2: AA players 8 & 9. These teams should not play each other.
  - d. All teams (those that Interleague and those that don't) should play by Interleague Rules Interleague Rules are used for TOC.
- **Time Limits:** there are time limits for all Divisions, listed in the Rules.

- **Hosting Section 1 10-12 Baseball:** tournament will take place at the same time as the West Region Senior Baseball Tournament.
- **Brackets:** the goal is to hand them out to the leagues in April.
