#### THE PRAY IT! METHOD OF BIBLE MEDITATION

Put the passage you are studying into the first person singular from you, turn it into a prayer,

And pray it back to God.

Thank you, Lord, for being my Shepherd, and that I lack nothing. Thank you for making me lie down in green pastures, and for leading me beside the quiet waters. Thank you for restoring my soul. Thank you for guiding me in the paths of righteousness for your name's sake.

Psalm 23:1-3

Help me, Lord, to trust you with all of my heart and to stop leaning on my own understanding.

Please give me the faith to acknowledge you in all my ways so that you can direct my paths.

Proverbs 3:5-6

Then write down your thoughts and prayers. And always ... always ... find the application to your life. Look for the timeless truth in the verse. Ask yourself: How do I look in the mirror of this passage? What am I seeing in the light of this truth? How does the verse or passage apply to my life right now? What does God want me to do about it? How can I put it into practice? What do I need to think or feel differently about? What is God asking me to do or stop doing, to believe or stop believing? How does he want me to live from now on?
