The stories of *Snow White*, *Rapunzel*, and *Rumpelstiltskin* are German fairy tales that were collected and written down by the brothers Jacob and Wilhelm Grimm.

The brothers' fairy tale collection—which also includes the stories *The Frog Prince* and *Hansel and Gretel*—was first published (in German) during the early 19th century. The tales have since been translated into over 100 languages.



The story of *Snow White* was the very first fairy tale to be made into a Disney movie.

In the story, it says that Snow White's skin is 'as white as snow.'

No one really has skin as white as snow. What the author is trying to tell you is that Snow White's skin had very little color (she was *very* pale). This type of exaggerated speech is called a **hyperbole**. A **hyperbole** describes something as better, worse, more, or less than it really is.

Examples:

I'm so tired I could sleep for a year.

I'm so hungry I could eat a horse.

My backpack weighs a ton.

I was so scared my heart stopped beating.

We waited forever for the bus to come.
