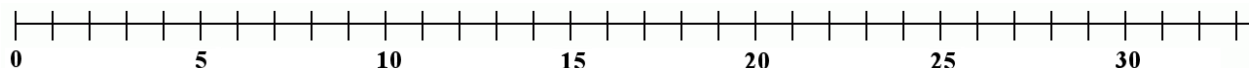
Grid Word Problems

1. Jayden, Elias, John, and Kayden each carved a jack-o-lantern for Halloween. When they finished, they roasted the seeds from the **4** pumpkins as a snack. If each pumpkin contained **59** seeds, how many total seeds did the boys have to munch on?

2. Isles, Ester, Karen, Dannyella, and Heivy went trick-or-treating together, and each girl collected **76** pieces of candy. If they put all their candy in one big pile, how many total pieces of candy were in the pile?

3. Use the number line below to multiply **4 x 6**.
(Remember: 4 x 6 means '4 sixes'— i.e. 4 jumps of 6 units each, *starting at zero*.)
