- 1. Your friend is 5 <u>times</u> as old as his little sister. If your friend is 10, how many *years* <u>older</u> is he than his sister?
- 2. Your cousin wants to buy a car. It costs 9 <u>times</u> as much to buy a <u>new</u> one as it does to buy a <u>used</u> one. If a <u>new</u> car costs \$27,000 how much does a <u>used</u> one cost?

How much money will your cousin save if he buys the used car?

3. You want to buy a new bike that costs \$170. Your neighbor offers to pay you \$6 a <u>day</u> to walk her dog. If you save all the money you earn, will you have enough for the bike at the end of 4 <u>weeks</u>?
