3. Elias and John picked apples for a Halloween apple-bobbing contest. Altogether, they climbed 14 trees and picked 28 apples from each tree. How many apples did they have for their contest?

5. Guy Fawkes put 36 barrels of gunpowder in the cellar under the House of Parliament. This was 4 times as much gunpowder as he actually needed. How many barrels of gunpowder did Guy need to blow up Parliament?
