

Weathering and Erosion:

Weathering causes the rock to break down




Erosion and transport moves the sediments downhill to another place




Sedimentary Rock Formation:

Eroded sediments end up in the water and begin to settle (sedimentation) With time, more layers pile up and presses down the lower layers (Compaction)






Salt crystals glue the layers together (cementation) Rock mass formed is sedimentary






