

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Pleasure: Pleasure classes to be ridden without spurs, whip or drop nose band – ridden one handed

Hack and Hunter: You may enter both hack and hunter if you wish but classes will be judged to type

Beginner ring:

- You can not compete in these classes if you compete in open hack/hunter classes
- Can compete in led classes

Attire:

- Normal show day attire is encouraged – however jackets are optional
- Plaiting is optional
- No stud/team or similar saddle cloths or clothing to be used in videos
- Helmets must be worn

Gear:

- Helmets – MUST BE WORN
- No boots or bandages allowed
- No tie downs/martingales or similar
- No top boots in rider classes under 18 years

Judges:

- Do not compete under judges that you know or have a strong association with
- Judge's decisions are final

Videos

- You may enter videos from previous shows providing it fits the criteria (e.g. correct workout and correct riding attire) if you are unable to complete new videos
