HEART & SOLE

The Girls Club at Vicksburg Family Development initially began as a pregnancy prevention program for 10-17-year-olds, with members nominated and selected based on risk levels associated with home life, sibling pregnancy, behavioral concerns, and more. As numbers grew, so did the focus. Meeting on Tuesday and Thursday each week, club members are mentored in a variety of areas including academics, career goals, and how to deal with anger. Due to location -Mississippi is the unhealthiest state in America – and an emphasis on overall wellbeing, it quickly became apparent that a fitness element was missing from the lineup. That is when the Junior Auxiliary of Vicksburg (JAV) entered the picture. After a brainstorming and planning session that included opportunities to introduce the Girls Club to a variety of exercise types and quality nutrition choices, the Heart & Sole project team began meeting with members on the second Tuesday of each month during the school year. In addition to covering the health-motivated portion of their program, project members also serve as sounding boards, advisors, "big sisters," and friends. Many of the girls are in the midst of difficult personal situations or are members of large families with working parents, and crave both love and attention. In addition to healthy lifestyle guidance, Heart & Sole is able to provide those missing elements. Simply put, team members become what the girls most need them to be.
