# Magdalene Feast Day

Last weekend, many of us attended the celebration of the Magdalene Feast Day hosted by Mythica and led by David Curtis and Ella Rozett.




Our intrigue of the past week has been the phrase "Do not cling to me, ....."

As we take a few minutes to calm our minds, we ask that we find comfort with our findings from our gathering.

## Do Not Cling to Me

- John 20: 11-18
- But Mary stood outside by the tomb weeping, and as she wept she stooped down *and looked* into the tomb. And she saw two angels in white sitting, one at the head and the other at the feet, where the body of Jesus had lain.
- Then they said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping?" She said to them, "Because they have taken away my Lord, and I do not know where they have laid Him."
- Now when she had said this, she turned around and saw Jesus standing *there*, and did not know that it was Jesus.
- Jesus said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping? Whom are you seeking?"
- She, supposing Him to be the gardener, said to Him, "Sir, if You have carried Him away, tell me where You have laid Him, and I will take Him away."
- Jesus said to her, "Mary!" She turned and said to Him, "Rabboni!" (which is to say, Teacher).
- Jesus said to her, "Do not cling to Me, for I have not yet ascended to My Father; but go to My brethren and say to them, 'I am ascending to My Father and your Father, and to My God and your God.'"
- Mary Magdalene came and told the disciples that she had seen the Lord, and *that* He had spoken these things to her.



#### THE HEBREW WORD devakut

- THE HEBREW WORD devakut () ותבקד means "cleaving" and refers to communion with God.
- Davak is used to describe how a man cleaves to his wife so that they become basar echad – "one flesh" (see Gen. 2:24)
- In Jewish mystical tradition, devakut is considered as the highest mystical step on the spiritual ladder back to God, similar to the "beatific vision" of some Christian traditions.

The Greek expression  $M\acute{\eta} \mu o \upsilon \ \ \, \check{\alpha}\pi\tau o \upsilon$  (Me mou haptou) is best rendered,

"Do not go on clinging to me" because haptou is a verb in the middle voice.

The middle voice is one that English lacks. It is midway between the active and passive voices and indicates that the subject of the verb (in this case, Mary) both acts and is acted upon.

• What the Lord asks of Mary is that she not merely cling to what is familiar but step back and see what is new. Jesus is no longer a mere rabbi or teacher. He is not merely the Jesus she knew; He is Lord and He is risen.

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## DIFFERENT INTERPRETATIONS, SAME BIBLE

Matthew 28:5 But the angel, addressing the women, said: "You need not be afraid. I know that it is Jesus who was crucified, for whom you are looking. He is going before you to Galilee. Remember, I have told you. They left the tomb quickly, in awe and great joy, and ran to tell the news to the followers. Suddenly Jesus met them. "Greetings!" he said. The women went up to him, and clasped his feet, bowing to the ground before him

Mark 16:1 Mary of Magdala, Mary the mother of James and Salome brought spices so that they might go and anoint him. They saw the stone had already been rolled back; it was a very large one. Going into the tomb, they saw a young man sitting on their right and they were dismayed; but he said, "Do not be dismayed, .....But go, and say to his followers and to Peter, "He is going before you into Galilee." They went out and fled from the tomb, for they were trembling and bewildered and did not say a word to anyone for they were frightened.

**Luke:24:1** But very early on the first day of the week they went to the tomb, taking with them the spices that they had prepared. They found that the stone had been rolled away and on going into it, they could not find the body. While they were at a loss to account for this, all at once two men stood beside them. But when in their fear the women bowed their faces to the ground, They said to them:" Why are you looking among the dead for him who is living? Remember how he spoke to you before he left Galilee...Then they remembered his words, and on returning from the tomb, they told all this to the Eleven and to all the rest. They were Mary of Magdala, and Joanna and Mary, the mother of James. What they said seemed mere nonsense and they did not believe them.

# The Gospel of the Beloved Companion

40:6 Yeshua said to her, "Miryam, do not hold to me, for I am not of the flesh, yet neither am I one with the spirit, but rather go to my disciples and tell them you have seen me, so that all may know that my words are true and that any who should choose to believe them and keep to my commandments will follow me on their last day."

40:8 Also there, were the disciples Levi, whom some have called Mattithyahu; and Joanna; and the other Saloma, to whom Yeshua had spoken at the well of Ya'Akov. The Migdalah told the disciples that she had seen Yeshua and that he had said these things to her. And they knew the truth of her and were all filled with great joy and believed.


