


Let's take a few moments to silence our minds, calm our bodies and open our hearts.

In the beginning, people prayed to the Creatress of Life, the Mistress of Heaven. At the very dawn of religion, God was a woman.

When God Was a Woman Merlin Stone The overwhelming consensus was that if Jesus had known erotic love, he could not possibly have also been the full embodiment of divine love. It would somehow disqualify him as the divine redeemer.

After nearly two millennia of reinforcement, the assumptions have become so much of the landscape of Christianity that they appear to be part of the seamless structure of revealed truth. But, in fact, *assumptions* are what they really are – not the core tenets of the faith, not anything that Jesus himself taught, but superimpositions of a male, celibate priestly theology ... written, shaped, formulated, and handed down almost exclusively by celibates talking to other celibates.

...the highly charged premise that *in addition* to all those other roles to which Mary Magdalene can lay just claim – apostle, visionary, healer – that there is one remaining to her, which may just be the most important of them all: soul mate.

[what in a healthy culture] would surely seem to be the obvious possibility: that they were faithful beloveds, whose lives were joined together in a fully enfleshed human love which was a source of strength and nurturance for both of them.

Miriam of Magdala first had to become truly woman, in all the sexual dimensions of her femininity, accepting and integrating her masculine nature as well before realizing her status as speaker and knower (a status that many refuse to recognize). It was only after all this long and patient work to become fully human that she, too, could truly join her Master as Anthropos, in a humanity complete and open to the divine, transparent, like he who was "more than Being: a Gift of the Good."

The Gospel of Mary, like the Gospels of John and Philip, remind us that Yeshua was capable of intimacy with a woman. This intimacy was not merely of the flesh; it was also emotional, intellectual, and spiritual. What is at stake here is total salvation, the liberation of a human being in his or her entirety, by imbuing all the dimensions of this being with consciousness and love. By invoking the realism of Yeshua's humanity in its sexual dimension, the Gospel of Mary in no way detracts from his spiritual and divine nature, the dimension of pneuma.*
