

## **The Lost Coin – March 7, 2021**

The Lost Coin ( A parable told by Jesus found in Luke 15:8-10 ) Or what woman, having ten silver coins, if she loses one, does not light a lamp, sweep the house, and search carefully until she finds it? When she has found it, she calls together her friends and neighbors, saying, "Rejoice with me for I have found the coin that I had lost." Just so, I tell you, there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents.

This week's video tells about that parable in another way.

Play the "Lost Coin Game."

1. Gather about 20 different coins- pennies, nickels, dimes, and quarters.
2. Play with three or four people.
3. All but one person closes their eyes. The one person removes a coin.
4. The person who guesses which one is missing first wins and another person is chosen to remove a coin. You can modify the number and types of coins as you wish.
5. Everyone has two chances to remove a coin before the game is over. Play as many times as you like!
