Alleluia!! Christ is risen! He is risen indeed!

Those are the words we share with others every Easter morning. Be sure to say them to everyone in your family and those you meet today.

Our scripture for today is:

“God has raised this Jesus to life, and we are all witnesses of it.” Acts 2:32 NIV

What appeared to be one of the darkest times in all of human history became the most joyful, as the world discovered that Jesus had conquered sin and death.

1. Watch the video about the Easter story to learn more of how Jesus' suffering, death and resurrection were part of God's plan that we all might be saved from sin and have a closer relationship with God through Jesus Christ.
2. Open and print the attachment “He is Risen” to find words that are important to the story.
3. Open and print the attachment “The Empty Tomb” and use water colors to paint in the picture. If you don't have water colors, you can use regular markers and maybe paint over the picture with a little water to help it look like a water color- or just color it in with markers. Then tape it to a window to see how the light comes through and remember that Jesus is the Light of the World.

Here is a prayer you could pray today or make up your own prayer. Remember to pray for others as well as for those you know and love.

Dear Lord, thank you for your Son, Jesus Christ. Thank you, Jesus, for dying for our sins and for rising from the dead that we might believe in you and know how much you love us. Be with us and those we love. Help those who are sick and those who have lost people they love. Please be with the poor. We want to serve others as Jesus did, so please show us how we can do that. In Jesus name we pray, Amen.
