

Welcome to the second Sunday after Easter!!

This week I need your help in reviewing a new video series for online Sunday school from Cokesbury. This lesson is one of a series about the events involving the disciples of Jesus as they went about spreading the good news of Jesus' teachings, death, and resurrection on Easter morning.

This week we will learn about Peter and John and the miracle they performed in the name of Jesus.

You can find the story in the Bible by going to Acts 3:1-26. In other words, find the book of Acts in your Bible in the New Testament. Go to the third chapter (the big 3) and start with the first verse and go to the end of verse 26 (the small numbers).

I have attached a video of a boy retelling the story.

Here is your challenge. Watch the video about the story. It is a story about a miracle of helping a poor and sick person. But it is also about the importance of telling others of the gifts of God through His Son, Jesus. We are learning important Bible stories but we also need to think about how we can spread the good news. So...

Pretend you are a TV or newspaper reporter (your choice).

If you are a TV reporter, make a video of yourself as a reporter on the scene of the Healing of the Lame Man (he couldn't walk) by Peter and John.

Or, if you are a newspaper reporter, write a short article about the event. Good news articles always include information about who, what, where, when and why. The why is very important- why did they heal the lame man?
