Next, team up with your friends or family members to make up a skit about Tabitha and Peter to act out the story. Here are the parts you will need: Tabitha, community members, and Peter. Look for some scarves and other things you can use to dress up like the people of that time. You will also need something for Tabitha to lie on when she is sick. Give it a try and remember the story is about the power of serving others and love.

Then, print the attachments and complete them. One is a page of hearts that are symbols of love. See if you can fill in any service you can do as an act of love like Tabitha.

The last activity is a craft for you. Cut out the clothes drawings. One is the front of a robe that Tabitha decorated and the other is the back of that robe. Color and decorate them to be spectacular (really cool) and cut them out. Then glue the back of the robe to a popsicle stick and then glue the front to the back with the popsicle stick between them. Draw and cut out a head to glue on and you have a Tabitha stick puppet! Yay!

After you have finished everything, be sure to say a prayer of thanksgiving to God for the kind people in your life.
