

Crawford Oaks Pool Rules

2017 Pool Season

Operating hours are 8 a.m. to 10 p.m.

Members must be in good standing (i.e. homeowner dues paid) to use the pool.

All homeowners **MUST** have their access cards with them in order to use the pool. Residents without their access cards may be asked to leave the pool area.

A member must accompany guests while they are using the pool. Maximum number of non-resident guests is (3) three.

Proper swimming attire is required. No cutoffs permitted.

All **non-potty trained** children must wear plastic, watertight diaper covers (rubber pants) **AND** swim diapers (Kimberly Clark Swimmies or similar). For health reasons, this will be strictly enforced. In the event of fecal contamination, the member responsible for the contamination may be charged a resident inconvenience fee of \$100 per day for each day the pool remains closed, plus the actual cost to decontaminate the pool.

All children under 14 years of age must be accompanied by an adult at all times in the pool area.

NO DIVING ALLOWED. NO EXCEPTIONS. This is a safety issue and not allowed in order to prevent injury.

No running, pushing or horseplay will be permitted in or around the pool. Parents **must be responsible** for the behavior of their children at all times. **Homeowners will be responsible for replacement costs pool equipment or pool furniture as a result of damage by themselves or their guests.**

All trash must be disposed of in proper containers. **This will be strictly enforced via the security cameras/access card reader and all residents who leave trash behind will be fined.**

Absolutely no gum or glass containers are allowed in or around the pool.

To help avoid possible infestation of insects and rodents, all leftover food and food containers **MUST** go home with residents. **DO NOT** throw food or food containers into the trash.

Do not bring food or glass bottles or glass containers into the pool area. Alcohol is not allowed and use of could result in deactivation of amenity access card.

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Confine smoking to the smoking area where the smoking station is located and dispose of cigarette butts properly.

No pets are allowed in the pool / pool area.

Music shall be maintained at a level of volume which does not disturb others.

Persons having open blisters, cuts or skin abrasions are warned that they might become infected and are advised not to use the pool.

Residents wearing excessive suntan oils or lotions are asked to shower / rinse off before entering the pool.

Weather or other hazardous conditions may require closing the pool.

Please do not open the gates into or out of the pool for anyone. All residents must use their own card for entry.

Members are encouraged to support and assist in the enforcement of pool rules so that all members may fully enjoy the facility. Please discuss all rules and pool safety with family members before using the pool.

If you are the last person leaving the pool, please make sure that all umbrellas have been lowered and all doors and gates secured.

NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY! SWIMMING and use of the pool are AT YOUR OWN RISK

Failure to abide by the above rules will result in law enforcement being called and/or the suspension of pool privileges.
