

## What should never be placed in a recycling bin?

- Garbage
- Hazardous Chemicals
- Oil, Antifreeze
- Paint
- Aerosol cans
- Light Bulbs or CFL's
- Food Scraps
- Dirty Diapers
- Glass (accepted in green roll off ONLY)
- Mirror glass
- Needles or Sharps or Syringes
- Pizza Boxes**
- Chicken Boxes
- Ceramics or window glass**

## Why aren't these items Recycled?

Unrinsed containers, garbage, glass, and hazardous chemicals are dangerous to the people that collect recyclables and work in the Recycling Center.

Unacceptable materials sent to the Recycling Center must be landfilled, which increases program costs.

## ELECTRONIC WASTE

TV's, Computer monitors, and Laptops are collected at the Recycling facility for \$20.00 each. Other electronic waste (such as computer towers, printers, DVR's/VCR's, etc.) is collected at the Recycling facility for \$10.00 each.

The Recycling facility is located between Eldora and Iowa Falls on M Avenue, north of Hwy. D41.

## APPLIANCES

**Appliances are accepted at the recycling center for \$15.00.**

This includes Garage Door Openers

## SCRAP METAL

Metal is also accepted at a rate of \$55.00 per ton. All wood, plastic and concrete removed. **Please separate metal from landfill material.**

## TIRES

Car Tires \$4.00 each

**Maximum 3 car tires**  
or weighed & charged

**Bulk Rate .13 cents / lb. or \$250 / ton**

Tires on Rims are \$5.00 extra for a price of \$9.00 (Effective 2/1/2018)

Nearly 3 million tires are discarded annually in Iowa. **Please dispose of your tires properly.**

## \*\* GLASS \*\*

**CLEAN** Container glass is accepted in the green Roll off containers **ONLY.**

(Glass cookware, mirror glass, light bulbs, wine and liquor bottles, or window glass are **not** acceptable.)

**Do not put glass in Red Recycling Bins!**

## HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Call for appointment from April to October.

These items are **ONLY** accepted at the

Recycling Facility: (not curbside)

Light Ballasts: \$10.00

Car Batteries: \$5.00

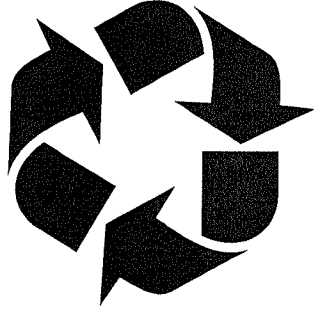
Large LP Tanks: \$8.00

**HOURS: (641-858-5904)**

Mon. - Fri. 7:30 a.m. - 3:00 p.m., also  
Last Saturday of the Month 9:00 a.m. -  
11:00 a.m. (No Sat. in Dec., Jan., Feb.)

### **POLICIES:**

#### Covered Loads:

All loads **MUST BE COVERED** or will  
be turned away!

#### Wind:

When the wind speed reaches 30 mph or  
greater, the landfill might close. Call  
**ahead before coming to the landfill.**

#### **FEES:**

Basic Charge: \$55.00 per ton  
(\$15.00 minimum up to 546 lbs.)

#### **HELPFUL HINTS**

If your material (such as metal) is  
separated in your loads to the landfill,  
this will help in disposing the material.

#### **ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED:**

The landfill does not accept any free  
liquids, machinery, dead animals, metal  
wire, hazardous waste, steel cable,  
flexible augers, large chunks of rubble,  
trees, or branches.

#### **BACK YARD COMPOSTING**

The landfill does not accept any trees or  
branches, but does accept leaves, yard  
and garden waste for their Yard Waste  
program.

#### **BINS AVAILABLE AT H.C.S.W.**

#### **ITEMS ACCEPTED:**

#1 - #7 Plastic (rinsed clean)

Tin (rinsed clean)

Corrugated Cardboard

Paper: Newspaper

Bulk Mail

Shredded Materials (put in  
a separate bag please, keep it  
tied shut!)

Books

Magazines

Box Board: Cake Mix boxes

Cereal boxes

Kleenex boxes, etc.

Styrofoam - large pieces ONLY

#### **UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS:**

**NO GARBAGE**

**NO PIZZA BOXES**

**NO CHICKEN BOXES**

**NO WRAPPING PAPER**

**NO TISSUE PAPER**

**NO KLEENEX / PAPER TOWELS**

**NO LIGHT BULBS / CFL's**

**NO MEDICAL WASTE / SHARPS**

**NO DISPOSABLE CUPS / GLASSES**

**NO STYROFOAM FOOD CONTAINERS**

**NO DIRTY PLANT CONTAINERS**

**NO BLACK PLASTIC GARBAGE BAGS**

**NO DRYER SHEETS**

**NOTE: Please do not place your  
unacceptable items in the drop off  
containers.**

#### **EXAMPLES:**

Appliances

Bags of Garbage

Oil Jugs

Batteries

Paint

#### **Preparation of Materials for Collection & Processing**

#### **Plastic:**

Remove lids and throw away, rinsed  
container clean

#### **Tin:**

Remove lids, rinsed can and lid clean,  
put rinsed lid in can and crush top of can  
to keep lid inside of can, remove labels.  
Put label with mixed paper.

#### **Corrugated Cardboard:**

Clean, emptied, flattened no larger than 2  
feet by 4 feet.

#### **Paper Items:**

#### **Separate by categories:**

Newspaper - place in a grocery sack and tied  
closed

Mixed paper - place in a grocery sack and tie  
closed, ETC.

#### **CURBSIDE CUSTOMERS:**

**PLACE BIN AT CURB BY 7:30 A.M.  
ON DAY OF RECYCLING**

**ALL MATERIALS MUST BE  
PLACED INSIDE YOUR BIN -  
LARGE FLATTENED CORRUGATED  
CARDBOARD - PLACE UNDER RED  
BIN**

Place all loose materials in the bottom of  
your bin, place the separated and bagged  
materials on top, and place the bin(s) out  
on the curb the night before your  
scheduled pick up or by 7:30 a.m., the  
day of your pickup. Do Not set out  
after they drive by. They will not  
come back and pick up your recycling.

Aerosols, Acids/Bases, Antifreeze, Ballasts, Rechargeable Batteries, Cell Phones, Cleaners, Fertilizers, Floor Care Products, Glues, Gasoline and Kerosene, Compact Fluorescent Light Bulbs (CFL's), Fluorescent Light Bulbs, used Motor Oil, used Oil Filters, Oven Cleaners, Oil-based Paint, Petroleum-based adhesives, Pesticides, Poisons, Pool Chemicals, Roofing Tar, Rust Removers, Sharps (only in proper containers), Shellac, Stains, Thermostats (Mercury Ones), and Windshield Washer Fluid

**Non accepted materials:**

LATEX PAINT, Air Fresheners, Ammunition/Explosives, Asbestos, non-rechargeable Batteries, Drain & Enzymatic Cleaners, Dry Cement Mix, Fire Extinguishers, Joint Compound, Laundry Products, Incandescent Light Bulbs, Liquid Cleaners, Medications, Non-Hazardous Waste, Potting Soil, Propane tanks, Sewing Needles, School glue
