## ACCEPTED

- Aerosol cleaners, paints
- Ammonia-based cleaners
- Antifreeze
- Batteries (only rechargeable)
- Fertilizers
- Fluorescent Light Bulbs (CFLs)
- Gasoline, Kerosene
- Oil, lead-based paint
- Stains, Varnishes
- Metal polishes, rust removers
- Thermometers (mercury)
- Thermostats (mercury)
- Pesticides
- Petroleum adhesives
- Used oil filters
- Sharps or needles (must be contained) Must be contained in detergent bottles or sharps containers (not milk jugs or pop bottles). Lids must also be taped.

## NOT ACCEPTED

- Ammunition
- Asbestos
- Electronics
- Explosives
- Fire extinguishers
- Latex paint
- Medications
- Propane tanks, cylinders
- Radioactive materials
