The December 15, 2025, Council meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM by Mayor Dave Mull. Council members present were Marc Havens, Kevin Pieters, Marvin Veld, Travis Hollander and Dave Mull. Cory Schurman was absent. Motion to approve the agenda was made by Kevin Pieters and seconded by Marc Havens. Motion was approved.

There were no comments or concerns from the public.

REPORTS:

Library – No report this month.

Fire Department – Truck #652 was down due to issues with the power steering. The cylinder has been repaired and installed. The department has had 52 calls to date for the year. Everything else seems to be going well.

Public Works – Pump #2 is being repaired. Cooley's is pumping protein from the Naturally Recycled Proteins plant, and the city receives reimbursement for each load. This helps with the micros at the sewer plant and helps it be more efficient. The test numbers have been good. Having issues with the fans being frozen but they feel this is due to the extreme cold temperatures and the condensation freezing. Motors are fine.

NEW BUSINESS:

- A. Jarret Wininger presented a proposal to the city for a full hookup campground. He was inquiring about the possibility of hooking up to city water and sewer and what that would entail. There would be approximately 40 sites with year-round service and possibly breaking ground in the spring. The city inquired if he would be opposed to being annexed into the city limits and his response was it would like to consider both ways to see which would work in his best interests.
- B. Water/Sewer Rates: They discussed the rates and decided to wait until July to make the decision concerning the rates.
- C. Iowa Pump Quotes: The mayor had talked with the council members prior to the council meeting due to a decision needing to be made to get the pumps repaired. The council was okay with going ahead with the repairs to the pumps. The repairs are in process.

The motion to adjourn was made by Kevin Pieters and seconded by Marc Havens. Meeting was adjourned at 7:35 PM. The next meeting will be on January 12, 2026.
