WHAT IS AN INDULGENCE?

"An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury of the satisfactions of Christ and the saints."

"An indulgence is partial or plenary according as it removes either part or all of the temporal punishment due to sin." Indulgences may be applied to the living or the dead.

(Canon 992-993)

During **Nov. 1-8 and throughout November**, one can gain the indulgence and their application to the souls in purgatory by meeting these conditions:

A plenary indulgence:

granted under the usual conditions: Sacramental Confession, Eucharistic communion, and prayer for the intentions of Supreme Pontiff

Some means of Gaining Plenary Indulgence:

- Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament for at least 30 minutes
- Scripture reading for at least 30 minutes
- Way of the Cross recited
- Rosary prayed in a church or with a family group or religious community.

A partial indulgence:

granted to the faithful who, at least with a contrite heart, pray to the merciful Lord Jesus a legitimately approved invocation.

Some means of Gaining a Partial Indulgence:

- Praying the Magnificat
- Praying the Acts of Faith, Hope, and Love, and the Creed
- Making the sign of the cross
- Visit to the blessed sacrament
- Visit to a cemetery

EUCHARISTIC MIRACLES OF THE WORLD EXHIBIT


