

How to Build a Ouija Board

How to Make a Ouija Board



A homemade ouija board that "answers" questions fluently can be made from a clear perfectly straight board about 20 inches long, 14 inches wide, and 3/8 inches thick. Round off the corners and sandpaper it until smooth. Trace on it the letters of the alphabet with a pencil, and black them with a brush; also trace the words "yes" and "no," and the numbers, and at the bottom the word "Good-by." Coat the board with two coats of varnish, and rub smooth. While the board is drying the table can be made. Cut from a board of 3/8-inch material a heart-shaped piece 4½ inches wide at the widest point and 6 inches long. Next make the three wooden legs 2 inches long and glue them into holes in the under side of the table. Cut three disks of felt from an old hat and glue one to each foot of the little table
