



## Investigating Paranormal Anomalies Code of Conduct

All participants agree to uphold the integrity of ghost hunting and agree to this **CODE OF CONDUCT** with participation as an Investigation Team in any Event. All understand that failure to do, so may lead of immediate extradition from the event and any representation or association to it. Team Members, venue representatives, volunteers and their attendees will ...

1. Conduct all investigations in a professional, appropriate and responsible manner. All investigations will be conducted with highest level of integrity and honesty.
2. We will always respect the law and any legal Authority.
3. We will honour all obligations and commitments to the team and the property investigated.
4. Ask the spirits of the dead for permission to communicate with them. Thank them for the opportunity. Spirits will not be interrogated or treated without respect, no matter what the conditions.
5. Respect posted property, ask permission and do not trespass areas that are not designated within the ghost hunt.
6. No use of Ouija boards or conduct séances during or after an investigation during the ghost hunts without prior permission first.
7. No smoke tobacco or other inhalant products during the investigation.
8. No drink alcohol (or other illegal mind-altering drugs) before, during or after the investigation if remaining on site.
9. Not engage in running or horse play in the property during, before or after the investigation.
10. Show reverence and respect in cemeteries, battlefields, and other historical sites.
11. Respectful use of provided ghost hunting equipment and return to its owner after usage.
12. Never knowingly be involved with misleading or dishonest activity, re-create untruthful evidence, including falsified images, recordings or data.
13. Keep aware that a Positive Mental Attitude is very important for all investigations.
14. Remember that sceptical minds may generate negative energy during an investigation.
15. Voluntarily take full responsibility for his/her own safety and welfare. The event accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage to anyone's property or for any injury however caused.
16. Ask permission by the owner(s) before publishing photos or data on websites or social media
