Pseudonyms will be used to identify individuals, addresses, street names, and other easily recognizable unique features of locations. Actual names of individuals and places will not be disclosed so as to guarantee complete anonymity unless requested otherwise by you the participant.

Once the investigation has been concluded the data will be analyzed and be available for your review should you wish to see the outcome.

If accidental property damage occurs as a result of investigator actions, the investigator will be held liable for costs. If accidental injury occurs to investigator(s) during the investigation you the participant will not be held liable for costs.
