THE MIDWEST CONFERENCE LAY ORGANIZATION WANDA JOYCE HOLLY JENKINS SCHOLARSHIP

The Wanda Holly Jenkins Scholarship is to be presented to students who are members of one of our African Methodist Episcopal Churches within the Midwest Conference. Its purpose is to assist worthy young persons of the Christian Faith in obtaining a degree in higher education. The Midwest Conference Lay Organization of the African Methodist Episcopal Church will administer the funds for this scholarship.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. An active member of an African Methodist Episcopal Church within the Midwest Conference
- 2. Must have a GPA of 2.5 or better
- 3. Must enter HBCU in the Fall term of 2025
- 4. Must pursue courses leading to a higher education at a HBCU (Historically Black College or University)
- 5. Must display a positive Christian attitude

THE SELECTION PROCESS A judging committee composed of members of the Midwest Conference, or their designees, will use established requirements to determine the scholarship recipients. The judges will evaluate eligible applicants: academic record; reference letters; qualities of leadership; extracurricular activities and accomplishments. The recipients will be notified in writing. All decisions by the judges are final. No material will be returned. Applications not completed in full or not received by deadline, will not be processed.

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT

The scholarship winners will be announced at the organization's Annual Lay Convention. Proof of enrollment must be received by the organization for the final awarding of the scholarships. If appropriate documentation is not received for each semester, scholarship funds will be returned to the organization's general scholarship fund.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

The following documents **must be presented** along with the application:

- 1. The **completed application form must** be typed or print (legible) in ink.
- 2. A sealed envelope with the current high school transcript, signed with official stamp mailed directly to the Scholarship Committee Chair. No copies accepted.
- 3. Submit **Involvement Form or resume.**
- 4. A minimum of one **letter of reference** from your current Pastor and/or President of your Local Lay Organization.
 - More than one letter of recommendation is encouraged and may be from your Sunday school teacher; a high school teacher; Principal; counselor or other community members.
 - The letter must be addressed specifically to the Wanda Joyce Holly Jenkins Scholarship.
- 5. Local Lay Organization's Fair share must be paid to be eligible.
- 6. All information must be postmarked by the deadline date of May 20, 2025.

A review of all listed materials by the President or member of the Local Lay Organization prior to submitting to the Scholarship Committee is advised.

THE COMPLETED APPLICATION AND REQUIRED MATERIALS MUST BE RECEIVED AND/OR POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN MAY 20, 2025.
