Begins sunset April 15th through sunset 16th

Begins on sunset April 18 and counts up for 50 days

- April 19th The Risen Lamb of Elohim

## **Festival of First-Fruits (Shavuot) Omer day 50**

Begins sunset June 5 to sunset June 6th

- **First-Fruits Watch** on June 5th from 9 pm to 12 am. Details to be announced
- **Set Apart Gathering with a devotional and fellowship:** Monday, June 6th @ 11 am. Bring your own lunch and 2 loaves of yeast bread to wave and share.

## **Remembrance of Soundings (Yom Teruah)**

Begins sunset September 27th through sunset 28th

- **Set-Apart Gathering Service Tuesday, 27th @ 7 pm** (bring shofar)  
The 28th is a High Sabbath

## **Day of Coverings (Yom Kippur)**

Begins sunset October 6th through sunset 7th

- **Set-apart gathering Friday, Oct. 7th at 12 noon** (prayer and fasting day)

## **Festival of Booths (Sukkot) - for 7 days**

Begins sunset October 11th through sunset 18th

- **Set-Apart Gathering Wednesday, 12th @ 10 am service and fellowship.**  
Bring your own lunch fellowship following the service. (Desserts provided)

## **The Great Day (Shemini Atzeret) 8th Day**

Begins sunset October 18th through sunset 19th

- **Set-Apart Gathering Wednesday, 19th @ 10 am service and fellowship.**  
Bring your own lunch fellowship following the service. (Desserts provided)
