

IRP 101

What is an IRP?

An IRP requires a utility to predict their customer's power needs for the next 15-20 years, and how they plan to invest in renewables.

Who approves or denies the IRP?

The Michigan Public Service Commission (MPSC) has 300 days to approve, deny, or recommend changes to the IRP.

What outreach is Consumers required to do?

Customer and public outreach engagement early in the development of the IRP is strongly encouraged.

What is required in the IRP?

Renewable energy investment, energy waste reduction strategies, demand response issues, fuel and generation needs, all must be reported.

Why is it important?

The IRP provides Michigan ratepayers an opportunity to voice their opinion on how they would like to see their utility meet their energy needs.
